3. BEFORE BEGINNING WORK MAKE SURE TO SET PARKING BRAKE AND CHOCK WHEELS

NOTE: On some vehicles it may be necessary to use a form of load booster to decrease the vehicle's front suspension sag with the snow plow in place. This can be accomplished with the use of supplementary air bags, booster springs, or similar load boosting devices. Since there are different load boosting devices available, it will up to the customer/end user to decide and purchase the product to suit the application, and not the responsibility of Sno-Way International, Inc.



INSTALLATION NOTES

- 1. Unless otherwise specified, mount all Subframe Components to vehicle before tightening any hardware.
- It is recommended that LOCTITE®, or similar thread locking product, be used on ALL mounting hardware (i.e. Nuts, Cap Screws, Bolts, etc.).
- 3. Vehicle should be parked on a level surface with a normal vehicle load on the FRONT suspension.
- 4. Items in parentheses () refer to quantity required for this step. Items in parentheses with a pound sign (#) indicate the part number as found in the parts list on the last page of this document. Example: (2) 5/8" - 11 x 2" Cap Screws (#10).
- It maybe necessary to relocate license plate holder. Check state and local laws for placement, if applicable.

MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Remove air dam from front of vehicle. (Retain with hardware for future use if plow is removed.)
- 2. Remove tow hooks. (Retain with hardware for future use if plow is removed.)
- Remove the four existing bolts holding the skid plate, retain hardware and remove corners for clearance. Retain for reinstallation in Step 9.




- 4. Position Side Weldment, DS (#2) to the front frame rails of the truck. Using the (3) M14-2.00 x 50mm Cap Screws (#12), (3) M14 Lock Washers (#13) and (3) 9/16" Flat Washers (#19) provided, bolt the Side Weldment, DS (#2) through the outside of the frame into bumper brackets (NOTE: Bracket holes may need opening to accomodate to frame).
- Using (1) 1/2"-13 x 1-1/2" Cap Screw (#16), (2) 1/2" Flat A Hardened Washers (#14), (1) Plate Backing (#5) and (1) 1/2" Nylock Nut (#15) bolt through slot in Side Weldment, DS (#2) into truck frame rail.
- 6. Using (1) 5/8"-11 x 2" Cap Screw (#9), (1) 5/8" Flat Washer (#10) and (1) 5/8" Nylock Nut (#11) bolt through rear section of Side Weldment, DS (#2) and truck engine cross member.

NOTE: If holes for mounting the rear section of the weldment are not present in the engine cross member, the following steps will be necessary. While the weldment is fastened by three outer holes in front section, drill 21/32" or 17/32" holes where necessary. Drill 1/4" pilot holes before drilling final size to make drilling easier. See parts list for hole identification.

- 7. Using the (1) 1/2"-13 x 1-1/4 x 13" Handle Bolt Weldment (#4), (1) 1/2" Flat Washer (#18), (1) 1/2" Lock Washer (#17) and (1) 1/2"-13 Nylock Nut (#15) bolt through rear section of Weldment, DS (#2) and truck engine cross member.
- 8. Use the (3) front inner holes in the Side Weldment, DS (#2) as a template, then center punch and drill 1/4" pilot holes through the frame rail in each position. Drop the Side Weldment, DS (#2) out of the way and re-drill the 1/4" pilot holes to 21/32". Using the (1) Handle Bolt Weldment 5/8"-11 x 2" x 7" (#6), (2) 5/8" Flat Washers (#10) and (1) 5/8" Nylock Nut (#11) bolt through rear most hole and into truck frame. Using (2) 5/8" 11 x 2 Con Service (#0) (4) 5/8" Elect (2) 5/8"-11 x 2 Cap Screws (#9), (4) 5/8" Flat Washers (#10) and (2) 5/8" Nylock Nuts (#11) bolt through front inner holes.
- 9. Repeat Step 4 to install the Side Weldment, PS (#3). Re-install the skid plate removed in Step 3.

10. Install the Vehicle Receptacle Member (#1 - Found in Power Pack Assembly) to the DS and PS Side Weldments using (8) 5/8"-11 x 1-3/4" Cap Screws (#7), and (8) 5/8" Hardened Washers (#8).



IMPORTANT: Height from the bottom of the Vehicle Receiver Member to the ground should be between 8" and 11" for proper operation.

11. Using the Torque Specification Chart provided, torque all Cap Screws starting at the rear and working forward.

REMEMBER After 5 to 10 hours of snowplow usage, re-torque all cap screws.


